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A. B. CHAUDHARI, J.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.92 dated 22.06.2016 registered under Section 406 IPC at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 26.09.2016. Pursuant to that order the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is Secretary of the Samiti which was entrusted with the paddy for milling. Except receiving the goods, no further role can be ascribed to the petitioner-Secretary.

Per Contra, learned State counsel submits that 37532 bags of paddy have not been recovered for which the petitioner is responsible.

In my opinion, the State Police is always at liberty to find out the whereabouts of the huge quantity of the bags of paddy, with that liberty reserved in favour of the State-Police, the interim order dated 26.09.2016 is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
