It is contended that petitioner No.1 – Manpreet Kaur, aged about 27 years has got married with petitioner No.2- Anil @ Anil Kumar, aged about 25 years, against the wishes of her family members, arrayed as private respondents No. 5 to 8, who are threatening to interfere in their marital life and as such to seek protection against interference in their lives and liberty by such private respondents and persons claiming under them, they have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to SSP,

Chandigarh, to look into the grievances of the petitioners and to take necessary measures to ensure that lives and liberty of the petitioners are not jeopardized at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 8 or persons claiming under them.

However, this order shall not validate the marriage between the petitioners and shall not have any effect on any civil or criminal action to which the petitioners may be found liable, under the law.
