ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.43 dated 10.07.2017, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 506 & 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Purana Shala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that even as per the allegations in the FIR, no injury is attributed to the petitioner who is stated to be armed with Kirpan. The other three accused who are named in the FIR, have been attributed injuries to the complainant and two injured.

This Court, by the order dated 08.09.2017, had directed the petitioner to join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajwinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 08.09.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
