Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.50 dated 25.03.2017 registered under Sections 224, 332, 353, 307, 436, 186, 148, 149, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 52 of Prisoners Act, at Police Station City, Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for petitioner contends that co-accused Parivartan Singh has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 13.11.2017 passed in CRM-M-41220-2017 and co-accused Gurbhej Singh has also been granted regular bail by the trial Court. The petitioner is in custody since 19.05.2017. No recovery has to be effected from the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposed

the bail to the petitioner.

Considering over all facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case and treating the case of the petitioner on parity with that of his co-accused Parivartan Singh, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted regular bail, during the trial, subject to his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
