Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 13.6.2001 passed by the Land Acquisition Collector, Hisar, whereby in an application filed under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, compensation was re-determined. Subsequently, the application, filed by the land owners for correction of the award on account of clerical error, was allowed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submitted that the issue raised in the present petition is squarely covered by an order dated 13.3.2014 passed in CWP No. 18807 of 2001 titled as “Union of India Versus Smt. Sarbati and others”.
