The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.165 dated 16th August, 2016, registered under Sections 302, 506, 336, 148, 149, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'the IPC') (Offence under Section 201 of the IPC added later on) and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

Mr. R.S. Sidhu, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed his Power of Attorney today in the Court;

Be kept on record.

Heard.

It transpires that *de novo* trial in the case is yet to commence after accused-Baggi Singh was summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

The petitioner was arrested on 16th August, 2016 i.e. more than one year ago. Allegations against him are similar to those against co-accused persons, namely Mandeep Singh and Gagandeep Singh, who have been granted bail earlier by a Co-ordinate Bench on 26th of May, 2017, and by this Court on 4th of August, 2017, inasmuch as all these accused persons (excluding Baggi Singh) were armed with sharp edged weapons at the relevant time.

So considering the long detention undergone by the present petitioner, namely Dharwinder Singh @ Bhinda, he is also ordered to be released on regular bail on the ground of parity, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate concerned.
