The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.499 dated 10.06.2017 under Sections 148/149/323/325/341/506/379-A IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (Section 379-A IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act were deleted later on), registered at Police Station Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a family dispute and the complainant is nephew of petitioners No.1 and 2 and cousin of petitioners No.3 and 4. He further contends that although Section 379-A IPC and 25 of Arms Act were mentioned in the FIR, but later on during the course of investigation, the same were deleted. He further contends that injuries on the person of complainant are simple in nature.

This Court, by the order dated 12.09.2017 had directed the petitioners to join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kailash, states that in pursuance to the order dated 12.09.2017 the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 12.09.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
