ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 92 dated 22.09.2011, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners in the FIR are that they had not made the entire payment for the paddy which they had received from the complainant firm. He further contends that the petitioners are directors of the company which had been conducting the business with complainant firm for several years and the instant FIR has been lodged to recover the balance amount which is purely a commercial transaction, with civil consequences.

This Court vide order dated 12.09.2017, had directed

the petitioners to appear before the trial Court and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Hardayal Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 12.09.2017 the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 12.09.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
