The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 134, dated 07.09.2016, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 27.09.2016 had passed the following order :-

“Notice of motion to the respondent for 4.11.2016.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioners shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail in FIR No. 134 dated 07.09.2016, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur, on furnishing of their bail bonds amounting to Rs. 10,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Sat Parkash of Police Station Dirba states that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not necessary.

In view of the above, the order dated 27.09.2016, whereby ad-interim bail was granted to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
