Notice of motion to official respondents.

On the asking of Court, Mr. H.S. Grewal, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. A copy of the paper book be handed over to him.

Mr. Zorawar Singh Chauhan, Advocate puts in appearance on his own on behalf of private respondents No.4 to 7, who all are present in Court in person as well.

On the asking of private respondents, petitioner No.1 Baby had interacted with her parents but refused to bow to their requests of returning back to their home. At the same time, private respondents have assured the Court that they will not take law in their own hands and have no objection if the couple chooses to reside together.

In the light of the same, the petition stands disposed off with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P5) within the framework of law. Meanwhile, the official respondents shall ensure due protection to life and personal liberty of the petitioners and shall take prompt and immediate action in accordance with law in case any instance of threat is brought to their notice by the petitioners.
