Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.149 dated 24.10.2010 under Sections 323, 324/34 I.P.C. (Section 325 IPC added lateron) pertaining to Police Station City Rupnagar, on the basis of compromise dated 14.12.2016 (Annexure-P3).

Vide order dated 07.07.2017, both the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate on 20.07.2017 to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Magistrate to furnish report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties appeared before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar and got recorded their statements for compromise and

report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide her covering letter No.854 dated 28.07.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Rupnagar vide Endst. No.7552 dated 29.07.2017.

According to the report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar, the compromise between the parties is out of their own sweet will without any inducement and coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.149, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
