The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.231 dated 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2017, registered under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Indri, District Karnal.

The petitioner was arrested on 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 as he was found in possession of 8 Kg. 100 gms. of “Ganja”. This quantity is well below the commercial limit. Investigation has since been completed but trial is yet to commence. There is no report of the

petitioner being involved in any other case of a similar nature.

As such, the petitioner may be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court, concerned.
