Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Balbir Singh and Avtar Singh in FIR No.261 dated 25.12.2016 under Sections 302 and 323 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated September 12, 2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have surrendered before the trial Court and have been admitted on bail on their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. In support of his contention, he has also produced a certified copy of order dated

27.09.2017 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur. The same is taken on record.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition no more survives as the same has become infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.

However, the petitioners shall continue to appear before the trial Court and shall face the trial in accordance with law.
