The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.109 dated 24.07.2017 registered under Sections 22/61/85 NDPS at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the FSL report has not yet been received.

Police is directed to get the FSL report within one month and submit the same before the concerned Court.

In that view of the matter, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial Court for regular bail on filing of FSL report.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of the trial court. Such interim bail is being granted only for the reason that the report from the Chemical Examiner is awaited.

It is made clear that the petitioner will appear before the trial Court as and when required and in default thereof, it would result into cancellation of his interim bail.

Disposed of with liberty as aforesaid.
