Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to official respondents to hand over investigation of the case i.e. FIR No.26 dated 27.02.2017 registered under Section 82 of Registration Act, 1908, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, to some independent investigating agency including a SIT.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite the fact that aforesaid FIR was registered on 27.02.2017, investigation in the case has not been completed. The petitioner feels that the respondents are not conducting fair investigation.

For the aforesaid grievance, petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 27.06.2017 (Annexure P-16), but no action thereof has been taken.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. A.S. Dhaliwal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without making any observation on the merits of the case, but considering the fact that the FIR was registered on 27.02.2017, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, to look into the contents of representation dated 27.06.2017 (Annexure P-16) and to make an endeavour to expedite the investigation.
