Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.292 dated 14.08.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal.

Vide order dated 11.09.2017, the petitioners were granted *ad interim* bail and were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to aforesaid order of this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jai Bhagwan, does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 14.09.2017 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
