[2]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 7.

[3]. In this petition, the petitioner seeks a direction upon respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect her life and liberty and that of her family members from the hands of private respondent Nos.8 to 12 along with official respondent Nos.4 to 7. Respondent Nos.4 to 7 are local level Police Officers (Station House Officers), who allegedly in collusion with the private respondents have been implicating the petitioner and her family members in false criminal cases. According to her, those private respondents actually constitute the liquor Mafia of the locality and being aggrieved with the efforts of the petitioner's husband to bring them to justice have been implicating them in false cases and harassing and threatening them.

[4]. Without passing any comment on the merits of the petitioner's allegations, the present petition is disposed off with a direction upon respondent No.3 to take notice of the petition and to follow up the same in accordance with law by way of ensuring that adequate notice under Section 160(2) of the Cr.P.C. is given to the petitioner in the event of her being implicated in any criminal cases at the instance of the private respondents, and to also ensure that no unnecessary harassment is caused to the petitioner's family.
