Though the present petition had been filed under Section 482 Cr. P. C. for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 1 to 4 to conduct a fair investigation and to present the final report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C., at the time of hearing of the matter, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, confines his prayer for the issuance of a direction to respondents No. 1 to 4 to file a report under Section 173(2) Cr. P. C. within a time bound frame as the report had been prepared in March, 2016 but even after a passage of one year has not been filed before the competent court.

Learned State counsel submits that the report under Section 173 (2) Cr. P. C. in the FIR in question was prepared but the same was not filed before the competent court due to the pendency of the present petition. He, however, undertakes that such report shall be filed before the competent court within two weeks from today.

The afore statement made on behalf of learned State counsel satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner and that being so, the same renders the present petition infructuous with regard to the prayer pressed before this Court.
