ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.58 dated 30.04.2016, under Sections 336/506/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a sudden fight between the residents of same village, which has now been resolved. He further states that it is a case of no injury, although Sections under the Arms Act have been mentioned in the FIR but no fire-arm injury has been caused.

This Court by the order dated 12.09.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the

compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sunam, dated 06.10.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a sudden fight between the residents of same village, in which no injury has been caused, which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.58 dated 30.04.2016, under Sections 336/506/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
