RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK J. (ORAL)

Following order was passed by the Lok Adalat on 9.12.2002:-

“As per office report earlier, the appellant had died. Opportunity was allowed to bring on record his legal representatives but none of the parties had taken steps in that direction. In this situation, this appeal cannot be disposed of by this Lok Adalat and is returned to the High Court. As and when service is complete, the matter can again be put up before the Lok Adalat.”

However, nobody has taken any step to comply with the above order so far. None put appearance on behalf of the appellant on 22.11.2001, 25.1.2002, 16.5.2002, 1.8.2002, 8.10.2002 and 9.12.2002. Similar is the position today. Neither anybody has come present on behalf of the appellant to press this appeal, nor any request for pass over has been made. It seems that neither appellant nor his counsel is interested in pursuing the appeal.

In view of the above, present appeal is dismissed for non prosecution.
