ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 165, dated 16.04.2017, under Sections 324, 326, 364, 34 IPC (initially the FIR was registered under Section 307, 364 and 34 of IPC but later on Section 307 IPC was deleted and Sections 324, 326 IPC have been added), registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had caught hold of the complainant and dragged him in his car. There is no allegation that the petitioner has caused any injury to the complainant. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 04 months since the date of his arrest on 13.05.2017.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, states that the investigation has been completed, challan has been presented and even charges have been framed on 06.09.2017.

Heard.

In view of the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for over 04 months, investigation having been completed and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Gaurav @ Gauri is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
