Petitioner is 72 years of age and is apparently patient of Hypertension, Coronary Artery Disease, Ischemic Heart Disease, Cataract (eye prosh) Osteo arthrities, bilateral knee joint and ophthalmology. She has been on interim bail under the order of this Court.

This Court is satisfied that on account of age of the petitioner and she being a patient of number of diseases, she can be granted the concession of bail. She remained in custody for a period of three and half years during pendency of the trial.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner will remain on bail during trial on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

In case, there is any allegation of an attempt to tamper with the evidence, it will be open to the complainant to approach this Court for cancellation of bail.
