Allegations against the petitioner-Gobind Kumar in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.152 dated 22.5.2017 registered at Police Station City, Sangrur under Section 380 and 408 IPC, are that during his job as technician with complainant B4S Solutions Pvt. Ltd. he is alleged to have misappropriated the diesel of the company worth Rs.17,25,708/- as he was supposed to supervise the DG sets installed at 17 mobile towers leading to registration of the FIR.

Contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner are that the petitioner was only technician and was not supposed to look

after the maintenance of the diesel or its stocks and that he is behind the bars since long time.

The factual scenario has not been disputed by learned State counsel but he has opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner on the ground that the offence committed by petitioner was heinous.

Appreciating the submissions and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is behind the bars for the last almost 42 days and the investigation is likely to take long time and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for a long time, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
