Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 is for quashing of FIR No. 262 dated 24.11.2016 under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No. 7, Jalandhar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Learned State counsel, on instructions from H.C. Malkiat Singh, submits that in the aforesaid FIR, both the petitioners namely Nitin Pal Singh and Jasvir Singh have been acquitted by Judicial Magistrate Ist, Class, Jalandhar vide its judgment dated 21.9.2017.

In view of the fact that both the petitioners have been acquitted by the trial Court, present petition has been rendered infructuous.
