Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.261 dated 25.12.2016 under Sections 307, 323, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 302 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated September 13, 2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been admitted on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. In support of his contention, he has also produced a certified copy of order dated

18.09.2017 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur. The same is taken on record.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition no more survives as the same has become infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.

However, the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court and shall face the trial in accordance with law.
