The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 34 dated 27.05.2015, under Sections 406, 380, 120-B IPC and Sections 381, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 & 34 IPC added subsequently, registered at Police Station Nayagaon, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there are no allegations against the petitioner in the FIR and he has been arraigned as an accused as he is signatory to the compromise between the complainant and the main accused wherein the complainant has resiled.

This Court, by the order dated 27.09.2017 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the

satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 27.09.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner having joined investigation and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 27.09.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
