ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 422, dated 24.09.2016, under Sections 307, 427, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Gannaur, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that this is the case of no injury. The allegations against the petitioner are that he had shot a fire from his pistol at the complainant. He further states that the petitioner is in custody since 04.05.2017 and the matter has been compromised with the complainant. Learned counsel also contends that a similarly situated co-accused Sunder has been granted regular bail by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-18446-2017 on 26.05.2017.

Mr. Vishal Satija, Advocate puts in appearance for the complainant and states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

Heard.

In view of the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for over 04 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Rishi @ Pardeep is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
