Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is
for placing on record the photographs of marriage as Annexure P-5.

For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed
and the photographs of marriage (Annexure P-5) are taken on record.

CRM-M-33974-2017

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for
issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and
liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents i.e.
respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the
petitioners are major and have solemnized their marriage in accordance

with law. However, respondents No.4 and 5 are not accepting their

marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, petitioner No.1 had moved a representation dated 03.09.2017 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Vashisht, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

In view of the above, without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate remedial measures, as warranted by law, on the representation dated 03.09.2017 (Annexure P-4) submitted by petitioner No.1.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.
