Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioners seeks quashing of FIR No.41 dated 2.5.2012, under Sections 406, 494, 34 IPC, PS Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib as well as PO order dated 3.6.2013 (Annexure P-2) on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 30.9.2016, report of the learned SDJM, Gidderbaha has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion. In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed and the impugned FIR, along with all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/ compromise.
