Through the present petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.104, dated 05.12.2013, registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, at Police Station Fattu DHINGA, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise(Annexure P-2).
