The petitioner is seeking protection of his life and liberty as he is being allegedly threatened by the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn my attention to the representation sent to respondent No. 2 on 11.09.2017 (Annexure P-1). Learned counsel contends that the petitioner will be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider his representation dated 11.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law. Learned counsel further contends that he has received instructions from the petitioner that no complaint is pending against him.

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the representation dated 11.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner and take action, if necessary, in accordance with law.

However, the official respondents shall be at liberty to take action against the petitioner in accordance with law, in case there is any material against the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
