Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.115 dated 19.08.2017 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 as well as under Sections 485 and 472 IPC registered at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 14.09.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Balraj Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.09.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
