This order shall dispose of both the petitions i.e. **CRM-M-34153 of 2017** titled as **Vikas vs. State of Haryana** and **CRM-M-42424 of 2017** titled as **Jugnu vs. State of Haryana**.

Petitioner(s) seek regular bail in FIR No.05 dated 09.01.2017, under Sections 394, 395, 397, 420 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 54 & 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra, Haryana.

The plea was not considered earlier in order that the evidence of the victim is not recorded.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) has now produced on record the depositions of the victim and witnesses. Result thereof, shows that they have turned hostile and have not identified the petitioner(s).

In that view of the matter, the petitioner(s) be released on bail, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The **CRM-M-34153 of 2017** and **CRM-M-42424 of 2017** are allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner(s) be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner(s) to surrender their passport with the trial Court, if they possess the same.
- (iv) The petitioner(s) would file an undertaking to the trial Court that they will not commit the same or any other kind of offence in future.
- (v) The petitioner(s) shall report to the concerned Police Station on every Sunday and Tuesday between 11 am to 4 pm. The police shall keep surveillance on the petitioner(s).
- (vi) Petitioner(s) shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
- (vii) In case, the petitioner(s) violate the above said conditions, this order of bail comes to an end automatically without reference to this Court.
