This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for transfer of criminal complaint bearing No.COMA-39971-2013, dated 29.10.2013 registered under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act from the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Bathinda to any other Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further submits that the petitioner has no concern with the working of the firm as on 26.07.2012 he had surrendered the partnership of the firm. Paramjit Singh son of Baldev Singh fraudulently transferred the cheque of petitioner to the respondent which was dishonoured. As a result, respondent No.1 filed complaint against petitioner, said Paramjit Singh son of Baldev Singh and M/s Guru Nanak Pesticides & Fertilizers. The counsel of the respondent used abusive language against the petitioner and also threatened him.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone

through the case file.

No case for transfer of the matter from the competent Court of jurisdiction at Bathinda is made out. However, in the eventuality of any hindrance by the respondent in the smooth trial the petitioner is free to approach the competent authority on receipt of any complaint/representation. The competent authority shall take prompt action to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.
