DEEPAK SIBAL J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have married each other against the wishes of the parents of petitioner No.1 and on account of this act on their part, they are under threat of being eliminated at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6. In view of the above, seeking protection, a representation dated 30.01.2017 (Annexure P-5) was made on behalf of the petitioners to the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Ambala, District Ambala (Haryana) but to no avail.

In the above circumstances, the petitioners have approached this Court through the present petition.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, particularly the validity of the alleged marriage, the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Ambala (respondent No.2) is directed to forthwith consider the aforesaid representation dated 30.01.2017 (Annexure P-5) made on behalf of the petitioners and thereafter take

appropriate action on the same as is deemed fit in accordance with law to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
