Application is allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

CRM-M-35087 of 2016

Present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.419 dated 05.07.2016, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC (Sections 467, 468, 471 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the parties have settled the matter and as per terms of settlement payment of Rs.8,00,000/- is to be made to the complainant-M/s RPS International. The petitioner produced a bank draft for a sum of Rs.8,00,000/- in favour of the complaint-M/s RPS International.

Learned counsel representing the complainant affirmed the settlement of the matter between the parties and received bank draft

(photocopy taken on file) from the petitioner in the Court and further contended that he has no objection if anticipatory bail is granted to the petitioner. The petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 22.11.2016 for release of petitioner on anticipatory bail stands made absolute and petition is disposed of.
