This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 96 dated 10.07.2016, under Sections 354-A/506/120-B IPC and Sections 66-E & 67 of Information Technology Act (Sections 354, 354-D & 201 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station, Jamalpur, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has been compromised between the parties. This fact has not been disputed by learned counsel appearing for the complainant.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular

bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial
Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana.
