INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Farman has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.593 dated 20.08.2017, registered at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh, under Sections 5 and 13(2) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan And Gausamvardhan Act, 2015.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the basis of secret information. As per the allegations, the

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accused fled away from the spot after leaving an ox there and he was identified by secret informer only.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 15.09.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 15.09.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
