Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner No.1 in case registered by way of FIR No.55 dated 04.07.2017 at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 323, 308, 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner No.1 submits that in compliance of orders of interim bail dated 15.09.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner No.1 has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh, Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar Rural who submits that the petitioner No.1 is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from her and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

However, keeping in view the stand of the Investigating Officer and the stand of the State, the interim bail granted to the petitioner No.1 vide order dated 15.09.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and

conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.(challan).
Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
