This is second bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.20 dated 02.04.2017 registered under Sections 376, 323 and 506 IPC at Police Station SGN Dev Thermal Plant, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present FIR. The FIR is result of personal enmity as the petitioner had refused to help the complainant in her ill-designs against her husband. In fact, a litigation is pending between the complainant and her husband.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application. It is submitted that the petitioner is specifically named in the FIR. The petitioner had raped and threatened the complainant with dire consequences.

Heard.

This is second bail application. Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to show any fresh circumstance in favour of the petitioner. Otherwise also, there are allegations of rape against the petitioner. The name of the petitioner figures in the FIR specifically. No ground is made out to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
