Prayer made in the instant petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 31.07.2017 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2 with regard to his grievance. However, no action is taken so far.

Mr. Rana Harjaspreet Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction may be given to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar for redressal of his grievance.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar to look into the grievance of the petitioner and disposed of the same in accordance with law, expeditiously.
