The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.79 dated 05.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station City Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, in view of compromise.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Pursuant to order dated 30.09.2016 passed by this court, statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court. Looking to the report it is seen that the compromise is voluntary and without any threat, coercion and undue influence. I have seen the offences registered against the petitioner. Looking to the nature of the offence I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

(i) CRL. MISC. No.M-35155 OF 2016 is allowed.

(ii) The of FIR No.79 dated 05.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station City Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings qua the petitioner.
