The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 61 dated 6.8.2016, under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 323 and 313/34 IPC registered at Police Station Women Sonapat, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner herein was arrested on 9.9.2016 and has been custody since then. It is further argued that only the mother-in-law of the complainant has been charged under Section 313 IPC, in which she has been allowed regular bail. It is also argued that the trial is likely to take some time to conclude and, therefore, petitioner deserves to be granted regular bail.

Learned counsel for the State is not able to controvert the fact that the mother-in-law, who has been charged under Section 313 IPC, has

been granted regular bail in Crl. Misc. M 20541 of 2017.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner herein has been in custody for a period over a year, co-accused have already been granted bail and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
