The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.121 dated 11.08.2017, registered under Sections 384, 511, 506 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court vide order dated 15.09.2017.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custody is not required.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, at this stage, there is no *prima facie* case against the petitioner and the police is still collecting evidence.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 15.09.2017

is made absolute.

Prosecution is allowed to recall this order if the petitioner is found to be involved in any other case during further investigation.
