The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.45 dated 16.07.2017 registered under Sections 379-B, 427 IPC at Police Station City-2 Mansa, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are not ready to make payment of ₹10,000/- each to the Government, pursuant to order dated 15.09.2017 passed by this Court.

In that view of the matter, the said order is withdrawn.

Learned counsel for the petitioners heard on the anticipatory bail petition.

I have perused the FIR. Perusal of which shows that the petitioners had in full speed on motorcycle snatched mobile phone of the complainant and thereafter also speed out the motorcycle to run away. They were chased by the complainant. Eventually because of high speed their motorcycle hit the pot hole and they fell down and caught on the spot.

In that view of the matter, looking to the conduct of the petitioners in putting to danger the life of common citizen, the petitioners are not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail. Hence, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
