The petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.85 dated 22.5.2017, registered under Sections 21/29/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar. Except for the fact that the petitioner was named in the secret information, there is no evidence with the prosecution, as stated by learned Counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh. Since recovery of 400 grams of heroine was made from Sukhdev Singh and 100 grams of heroine from Dilbagh Singh, in that view of the matter, bail to the petitioner to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned on furnishing undertaking that he will not indulge in similar nature of offences in future.
