Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for anticipatory bail in case FIR No.141 dated 09.08.2017 under Sections 379, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner had nothing to do with the withdrawal of the cheque amount and the wife of the complainant had accompanied the petitioner in connection with withdrawal of the amount.

Learned State counsel contended that the allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature as cheques of Rs.3,17,000/- were forged and the amount was withdrawn by the petitioner and there is no ground for granting bail to him, and the present petition be dismissed.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the allegation against the petitioner is that an

amount of Rs.3,17,000/- was withdrawn by him after forging the cheque and

while doing so he was caught in the CCTV footage of the Bank. The entire matter required effective investigation. No case is made out for enlarging the petitioner on anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
