Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR
No. 62 dated 01.09.2016, under Sections 498-A/34 IPC, registered at
Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

It is informed that during the pendency of this petition, the
matter has been amicably resolved between the parties before the learned
Family Court, at Faridkot. Petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu
Marriage Act, 1955 has been filed by the parties. At the time of recording
of statements of the parties at first motion in the said petition on

19.08.2017, half of the settled amount has been handed over to the complainant.

Learned counsel for respondent no.2 affirms and verifies the factual position as above.

Learned counsel for the State affirms the aforementioned factual position. It is further verified that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond or that he is likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 03.10.2016, is made absolute.

Liberty is afforded to respondent no.2 to move an appropriate application in this matter in case the terms and conditions of the settlement between the parties are not adhered to by the petitioner.
