The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners herein for voicing an apprehension that they face a threat to the same at the hands of the private respondents on account of the fact that the petitioners have entered into a matrimonial alliance against the wishes of elders.

It is the contention of the counsel appearing for the petitioners that after the marriage having been solemnized and in spite of petitioner No.1 being a major, her parents/relatives have forcibly taken the girl away.

Even if the submission of the counsel is taken to be correct, the custody of petitioner No.1 presently would be with her parents/relatives.

Under such circumstances, there would be no basis for issuance of directions as prayed for in the present petition.

The present petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to petitioner No.2 to avail all his remedies as may be available to him in accordance with law.

Petition disposed of.
