Petitioner-Shiv Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.105 dated 13.09.2014, registered at Police Station City-2, Mansa, District Mansa, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, the money was paid to Bikramjit Singh, who is stated to be main accused and who induced the

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complainant for getting the Government job etc. As argued by learned counsel for the petitioner, Bikramjit Singh has been found innocent by the police.

From the record, I find that the petitioner has been in custody since 19.06.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
